The “Engaging Learners Program” offered by the Career Studies Department works with students who are presently not attending school by providing programming and training that will encourage students to return to school or to employment. The students attend two-three week retreats at a modern wilderness camp located 25 kms south of Cranberry Portage, Manitoba as component of the program. Retreat programs occur throughout the school year on a monthly basis. Retreat programs are separate for boys and girls. Room and board at the camp can be arranged.

The Prep Cook is responsible for assisting in the preparation of and serving all meals as required. Standard hours of work will be Monday to Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. with a half hour lunch break (work hours may be adjusted with input from the successful applicant). There may be a need to extend hours to accommodate clean-up at the end of the program. **Salary:** \$14.81/hour
