### PHOTOCOPIES

When sending in photocopies, please ensure that:

- All information is visible (title, author, ISBN, etc.)  
If the type is blurry, too dark, or cut off, we cannot catalogue the items for you.
- Indicate if you would like certain items catalogued for a special section of your library if it is not apparent from the photocopies
- Indicate items that are to be catalogued as a kit, and list items within.
- Do not photocopy more than one item per page as it is not always clear that they do not belong together.

### CATALOGUING OLD RESOURCES

If you have older materials in your library that have not been catalogued, or that you would like to have re-catalogued, please keep in mind the Weeding Policy as outlined in the Library Handbook.

For example, please note the copyright date and the condition of the items.  
Fiction, travel, geography, science and textbooks are usually discarded after 10 years.
