STRATEGIC PLAN DIALOGUE

At every meeting, a discussion takes place regarding the Strategic Plan and our three focus areas. The Board reviewed the Strategic Plan to determine additions or refinements to the three focus areas: academics, way of life and wellness. Administration provided recommendations for minor refinements that the Board accepted. A refined Supplement to the Strategic Plan and related documents will be distributed to schools, communities and Partners in the fall.

An update was provided regarding the August Gathering plans including the Envisio software program and training for administrators for school plan reporting.

The Board discussed plans for their October 2018 joint meeting with the Superintendent group with sole focus on the Strategic Plan and Supplement documents.

CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT EVALUATION

The Board was presented and accepted the completed 360-evaluation of the Chief Superintendent.

The Board approved the change in the name of "Mountain View School" to "Barrows Junction School". The change was result of a referendum vote where 74% of the people who voted chose the new name.

SCHOOL TRIPS

The Board approved outdoor wilderness/cultural activity trip requests from Helen Betty Osborne Ininiw Education Resource Centre (4), Skownan, Cormorant, Minegoziibe Anishinabe, Oscar Blackburn and San Antonio schools. The Board received information on a revised trip request from Berens River School.

COMMITTEE REPORTS and DISCUSSIONS

The Board received a report from the Finance Committee and the N.O.F.I. Board of Directors.

The Board received a Careers and High Schools program report and participated in a hands-on welding activity, similar to training students in Welding classes would receive.
